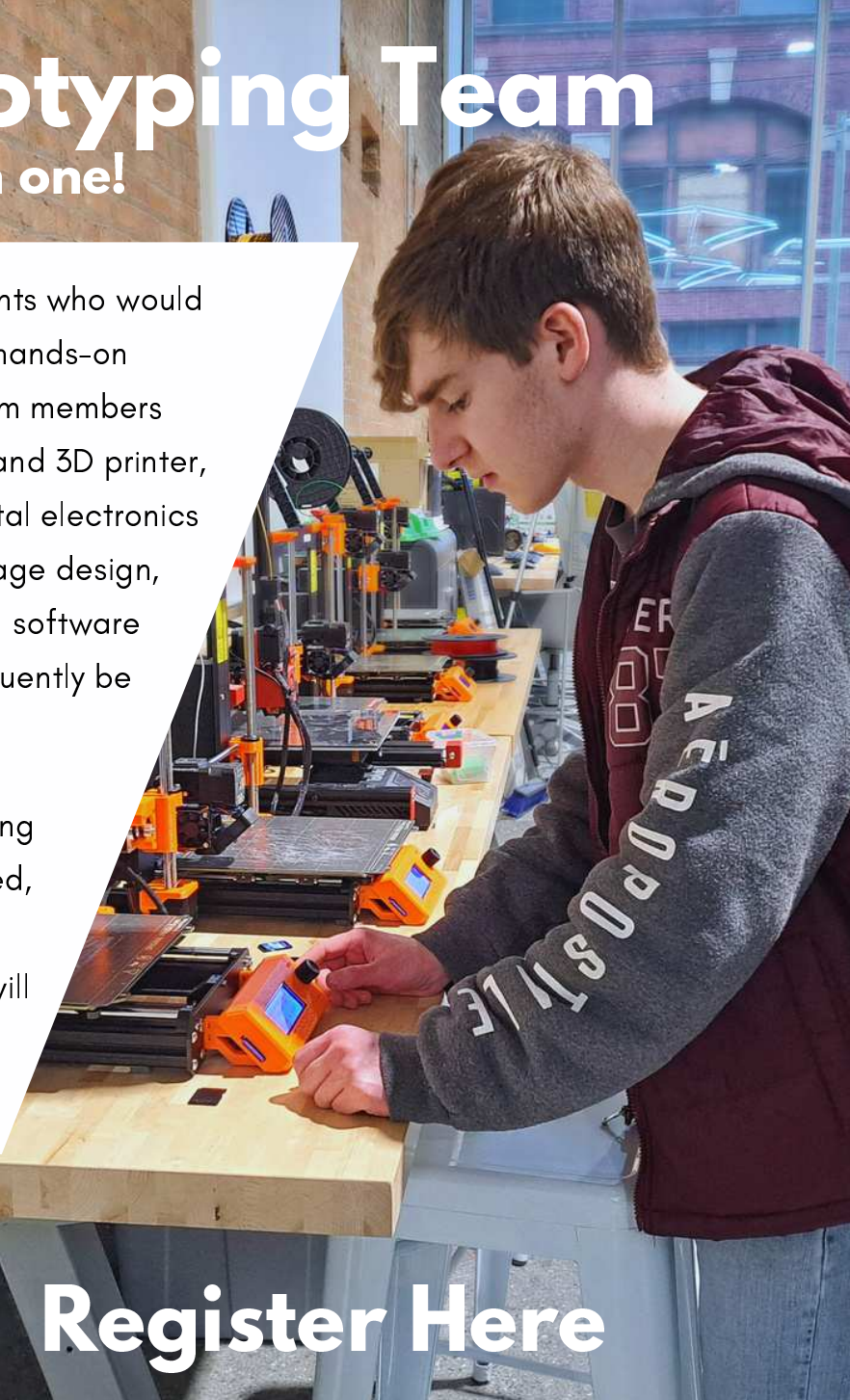


Summer Prototyping Team
